

How to use the ENKI Library for eBooks

ENKI is an online source of EPUB and Adobe PDF books which can be read for free with a library card and ENKI account.

You do not need an ENKI account to search for a title, but will need both your library card number (under the bar code on the back of your card) and a password within the Mono County Library Catalog to check out titles. If you do not have a password already set up for the Mono County Library Catalog, contact the staff at your branch.

Materials purchased for the ENKI Library shared collection intend to support a library's bestseller collections by providing access to

- popular fiction genres including romance, mysteries and suspense fiction;
- niche content - like classics, encyclopedias and graphic novels; and
- popular indie fiction and nonfiction

that meet the informational, educational, recreational, and cultural needs of the reading public. Titles are selected by library professionals state-wide and the collection is reviewed and refreshed on an ongoing basis.

Set up an Account

Use your library card number and Mono County Library Catalog password to sign in and set up an account. If you want to put items on hold, be sure to include an email address so you will be notified when the title is available.

Once you have set up an account, you will have quick access to your stored titles.
