At LEE VINING LIBRARY

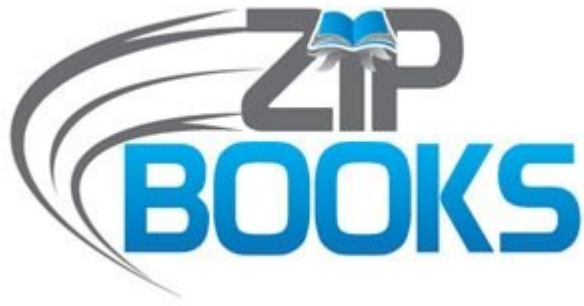
Use the library's needles, threads, and/or sewing machines to mend your clothes or other items. Mary Ljung will provide one-on-one assistance. No experience necessary.

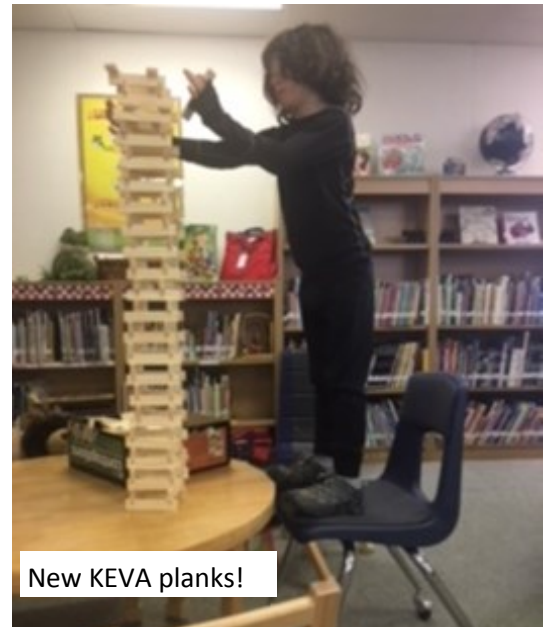


What is it? Zip Books is a way for you to request books that the Library doesn't own.

The item is shipped directly to you using Amazon Prime.

Requirements:

- You must have a library card.
- Item must not be available in the catalog.
- You can keep the item as long as you want.
- If you want a new title, you must return your current title.
- You may receive a total of 3 items in a month.
- The cost of the item must be under \$35.
- Item may be a Book, a Large Print Book, or a Book on CD.
