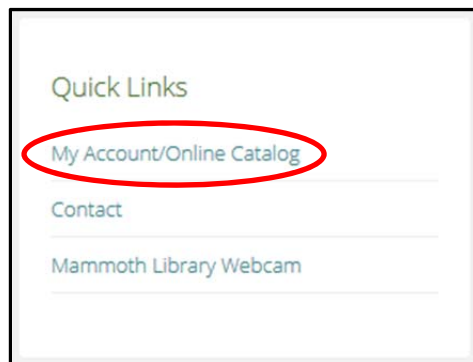


Mono County Library Online Catalog Search Linked to Library To Go (Overdrive) ebooks and audio books

Looking for a book through the Mono County Library's Online Catalog and we don't have it? Our catalog is linked to Library To Go (Overdrive), our free online source for ebooks and audiobooks.

To use this feature, complete the following steps:

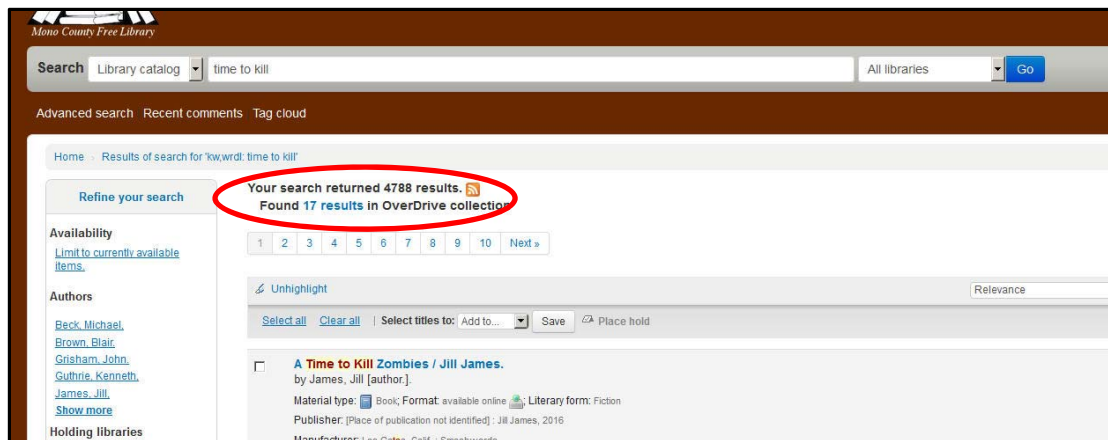
1. Access the Online Catalog from our website (monocolibraries.org) and click on the My Account/Online Catalog link in the right-hand column under Quick Links.



This takes you to the Search page for our Online Catalog.

Note: You do not need to sign in to your account in our catalog in order to use this function.

Enter the book name, title, or some combination of information in the Search box. Within the results, above any listings in our catalog, a link will show if copies are available through Overdrive as in this example.



2. Click on the “17 results” link, which takes you to a summary screen.
